Company at Christmas has become a long-standing Hands Together Ludlow tradition and has been running since 2017. We welcome people who would otherwise be alone up to Helena Lane Community Centre for a Christmas dinner with all the trimmings, followed by a choice of pudding. In 2023, 25 people spent the day with us and we also delivered hot meals to those unable to get out or cook for themselves.

Pre-booking is essential (and first come, first served) as we do have a maximum number that we can cater for. The day is full of festive cheer, good company and is run by our staff team and volunteers. The cost of the day is £10.00. Places need to be booked and paid for by **Monday 2**nd **December**. We may be able to offer transport for those unable to get to Helena Lane on their own, however, this is dependent on the volunteers' availability so is a limited service. On how he feels to have been nominated for this award, Mark said "It still doesn't feel real, I'm thrilled but nervous." We asked Mark what three words he would use to sum up why he volunteers at the Shed, he replied "Self-esteem, friendship, purpose" and agreed that volunteering had made a positive impact on both his mental and physical wellbeing. Mark hopes that this award, regardless of the outcome, will "help raise the profile and image of the Shed and maybe encourage more people to get involved."

Are you struggling to get to grips with your new smartphone or tablet? Wanting to start Christmas Shopping and not sure which sites to trust? We can help you with our 1-2-1 Tech Talk sessions! We have volunteer digital gurus who can help you with any questions or concerns you have around a device (smartphone, tablet, laptop, camera etc). Sessions take place on a Monday afternoon.

Have you got to complete an online form but don't have the facilities to start? Been told to order your prescription online and not sure how to? We have volunteers who can help assist with the competition of online forms and applications. The sessions run on a Wednesday and Thursday morning at our building. Wednesday sessions are designed to assist with forms such as Utilities, DVLA, Council Tax and Repeat Prescriptions. Thursday sessions are designed to assist with Carer's Allowances, Attendance Allowance, Blue Badge, Pension Credit, Buss Pass and Universal Credit (strictly not Personal Independence Payment).

To book a 30-minute appointment for either of these options, please call 01584 873062 or pop into the building and ask to speak to a member of the team. Please note you may need to bring relevant paperwork with you to the appointment.

Child Trust Funds

If you were born (or have a child who was) between 1 September 2002 and 2 January 2011 a Child Trust Fund (CTF) may have been opened for you, with cash locked away until you turn 18. The Government started everyone off with a free cash voucher of up to £250 (or £500 if your family were on low income), meaning every CTF within those dates had money in it.

To reclaim your CTF, you'll need to know which bank, building society or investment provider it's with. If you already know this, you can simply contact it directly. If you don't, HMRC has a handy tool where you can find out who your fund is with. Please note that you can't see how much is in the account through this link. You'll need to provide some details (National Insurance Number, phone number etc) and HMRC should tell you which provider holds the account within three weeks via post or phone, for you to then contact. If you're 16 or older you can do this yourself, just bear in mind that while you can find your CTF before you turn 18, you won't be able to access the money until then.
